Mr. Mattair graduated with a BS in General Psychology from Tufts College in 1952, married Roberta A. After an additional year toward a Doctorate in the same field at Purdue, he joined the Raytheon Company in Personnel Management and stayed with them for 19 years, prior to working as a Consultant on his own. His latter and final years of employment were in Saudi Arabia establishing Personnel Departments for two Saudi Arabian firms. He retired in 1987.
